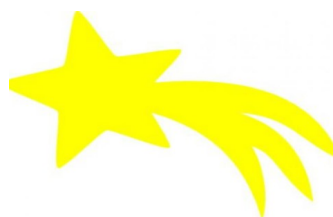


RESILIENCE PROJECT—
