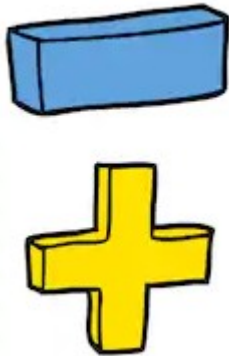
LITERACY:
